

# 40 Days of Prayer for Our Youth of New Hope Church and Community

## Prayer is the first Work of the Ministry

1. Pray for God to relentlessly pursue our youth and clearly display His love for each one of them personally.
2. Ask God to create an environment that is drenched with His Presence, worship, prayer, love, depth, unity, fun and laughter.
3. Pray for Student Ministries to be divinely protected and become a “cease-fire zone” from all the negativity, lies, heaviness and darkness they are hounded with from the enemy all week long.
4. Pray for God to raise a youth-led prayer team for Himself within KidZone, Ignite, Wildfire and Radiate!
5. Ask the Lord that when young people come to New Hope, they feel a place of belonging and safety where they are unconditionally loved and celebrated by God and their peers!
6. Ask God to protect our youth from Satan's vicious attack over their lives, especially those Satan has marked out for a life of addictions, destructive decisions or suicide.
7. May God give people eyes to see the youth in our area that are worth so much to Him, especially those drowning in depression and despair. May God reach into their hopelessness and grant them deliverance, support and ultimately - a life of miracles in His Presence!
8. Pray for God to dispatch a host of Angelic Warriors and assign them to each one of the youth in our area! May they guard and protect them so that our young people wouldn't even catch their foot on a rock! May God's Angelic protectors far outmatch the evil forces that accuse them and fight against them!
9. Ask God to turn absolute hopeless situations into His “Messes to Miracles” testimony for His glory!
10. Pray for the Lord to transform the hearts of our youth so that they love God, desire a relationship with Him, love to read His Word and spend large amounts of their time in prayer to Him!
11. Boldly ask God to set apart for Himself amongst our youth, a massive following of men and women who refuse to bow their knee to the gods of this world.
12. Pray for Christ to give them Daniel-type endurance, who refused to eat the King's food and defile himself against God. As a result, God gave him favor and wisdom beyond human understanding. May God do this again amongst our youth!
13. Ask God to give them a hunger to read His word daily and the divine ability to understand the Words of Scripture.
14. Pray for God to grant our young people the ability and urgency to memorize large portions of Scripture, storing up His Words of life while we still have access to the Bible in our culture.
15. Pray for our youth to have freedom from the selfishness and entitlement that plagues the youth of America. May our kids be exempt from the self-absorption that leads to isolation, confusion, and destruction.
16. Ask God to speak clearly to our youth through His Word, His Spirit, and the body of Christ so that they may easily hear from Him and learn to obey Him immediately.
17. Confidently ask God to raise up for Himself, Evangelists, Truth-Speakers, Helpers, Preachers, Business leaders, Givers, Teachers, Entrepreneurs and godly Fathers/Mothers who will fulfill and complete the work that God gives them to do.
18. Pray for the Lord to give our youth a powerful love for Him and a love for others that goes beyond any human love, making them willing to do whatever it takes to honor God and rescue people from the kingdom of darkness.
19. Pray for Wednesday nights, Sunday mornings and small groups to become places where deep healing occurs from the wounds that have injured our young people.
20. Ask God to change the way they think by renewing their minds according to Scripture. May His Truth rule in their minds and hearts, thus changing their personalities, behavior, emotions and actions.
21. Pray for our youth to come to love what is good and hate what is evil. May they be advocates for those who cannot fight for themselves and use the strength/power of God that lives inside of them to do extraordinary things for His glory!
22. Ask God to start a massive revival in Kidzone, Ignite, Wildfire and Radiate that cannot be contained and goes on to spread to every public school, private school, charter school and homeschool in the area!
23. Pray for the Lord to reveal to them their high worth in Christ Jesus, teaching them Who He Is and who they are in a way that sets them free from the love of man and the fear of rejection and failure.

24. Ask God to grant our youth the ability to communicate well, speak words of life and carry on a conversation even as they live in a world of texting and social media.
25. Pray for God to give them eyes to clearly see the attack of the enemy against them personally and how to stand firm and fight for victory! May they be as wise as serpents and as innocent as doves.
26. Pray for Christ to walk closely with them in their choices, helping place their foot on steady ground, clearly highlighting the right path before them.
27. Ask God to grant them wisdom beyond their years and PEACE-filled understanding of the absolute sovereignty and goodness of God.
28. Pray that God will raise up for Himself more Moses, Ruths, Jeremiahs, Abrahams, Esthers, Deborahs, Pauls, Peters and Marys from amongst our youth so that in these last days, many lives will be saved!
29. Ask God to strengthen our Student Ministry pastors and directors and all the volunteer Youth/Awana leaders granting them wisdom, endurance, protection, favor and delight in the work they are doing.
30. Pray for God to pour out His Spirit continually (never stopping) over our young people so that they may taste and see that the Lord is GOOD! May they crave Him as their highest need and greatest delight, reporting back to others the satisfaction they find in their God!!
31. Ask God to place a "Psalm 91 Divine Protection" upon our youth all the days of their lives.
32. Pray for the Lord to open doors that cannot be shut and shut doors that cannot be open for them. May they know their GOD and do great exploits for Him!
33. Ask God to wake up our youth mentally, emotionally, spiritually and intellectually – in every area - bringing about the abundant life that Jesus died to give them!!
34. Pray for our youth to be used by God to take large amounts of territory away from the kingdom of darkness. May God send them forth as beacons of light into dark places to rescue the perishing and save the dying!
35. Pray for our youth to accomplish all the work that God has planned in advance for them to do and be able to say with Jesus at the end of His life, "Father, I have completed the work that you have given me to do!"
36. PRAISE God for how He quickly raised up the funds necessary for the renovation of the Youth Center.
37. Ask the Lord to empower our young people to stand firm in the faith, being watchful, not wavering, fearless in faith and be found doing the Father's will when Jesus comes back again!
38. Pray for our youth to have a deep understanding of the work that was accomplished for them at the Cross of Jesus Christ.
39. Ask God to grant them a spirit of thankfulness/gratitude that leads to joy/strength. May that thankfulness be a guard around them, blocking out negativity, loneliness, selfishness, depression and paralyzing fear.
40. Boldly ask God to allow our youth to take their spiritual positions in the Hall of Faith... New Hope edition! May the faith of our youth be reported all over the world, throughout the Kingdom of Heaven, and even creating great fear in the kingdom of darkness! ALL to the GLORY OF GOD!!
