***“Better not Drift Away”***  
**Hebrews 2:1-4**

**Start It Up**

- **Opening Icebreaker:**

Describe a time when you experienced a “drift” in something like a vehicle or boat. Where were you? What happened?

**Talk it Over**

- **Sermon Summary...**

1. **Beware drifting from Jesus,** (v.1)
2. **...because it’s no small matter,** (v.2-3a)
3. **...and His gospel is too important.** (v.3b-4)

- Which part of the sermon impacted you, gave insight, challenged you, encouraged you or helped give direction to life?
- Hebrews 2:1 tells us to pay much closer attention to Jesus lest we drift. In your opinion, what is the connection between a person drifting from Jesus and drifting from the church? Are the two connected? Do they go hand-in-hand?
- From your experience of watching Christians “come and go” describe a situation where a friend drifted from the Lord. Looking back, what were the key reasons they drifted?
- On Sunday, Craig read a testimony of a couple who pressed through relational pain by processing key questions. Take time to ponder and reflect on these. Which one stands out to you and why?
  - *Why do we go to church?*
  - *Why do we go to this church?*
  - *How important is knowing and following His Word?*
  - *Can we actually forgive so-and-so?*
  - *What is there to learn in and through this?*
  - *Can we stand on the Chief Cornerstone even if all else crumbles?*
  - *Will leaving actually solve anything?*
  - *How can we trust Him like never before?*
- Describe a time in life you drifted from Lord. Or, does it feel like you are in a drifting season now? What does drifting feel like? What would bring you closer to Jesus?
- Some people don’t give up on Jesus, but they give up on a certain local church. Perhaps you’ve left a church before. Looking back, what were the key factors for leaving? How did it affect your relationship with the Lord? Is there anything you would do differently?
